- If you have someone in your family who has been shot... cross the line.
- If you have been shot... cross the line.
- If you have been suspended from school... cross the line.
- If you were raised by someone other than your parents... cross the line.
- If you own a gun... cross the line.
- If you have experienced the effects of alcoholism in your family... cross the line.
- If you play a musical instrument... cross the line.

- If you were in the Boy Scouts... cross the line.
- If you have visited another country... cross the line.
- If you speak more than one language... cross the line.
- If you have been in foster care... cross the line.
- If you had your own car in High School... cross the line.
- If you attended college on an athletic scholarship... cross the line.
- If you received an academic scholarship to attend college... cross the line.
- If you have a family member who has a bi-racial marriage... cross the line.
- If you have had a sports related surgery... cross the line.

Think about it first. Do you live in the city, suburbs or the country?

- If you currently live in the city... cross the line.
- If you live in the suburbs... cross the line.
- If you live in the country... cross the line.
- If you have ever worked retail... cross the line.
- If you wear/use contacts or glasses... cross the line.
- If you have been to Hawaii... cross the line.
